The only object of permanent heavy fortification open to public in Southern Moravia. The construction began in 1938 and it was finished after World War II. Czech Army used this log cabin until 1999.

The collection documents various technical and operational options from the beginning of public transport to the present.

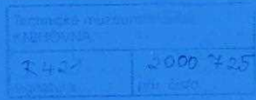

THE OLD IRON MILL NEAR ADAMOV
